

CCRS Dress Code

Males and females alike should make sure that their appearance is not distracting or immodest. You may be asked to run home and change if it is agreed by two or more leaders/pastors that your appearance may distract someone from worshipping God. If you have any questions please ask the Worship Director for further guidance. Our goal is to follow Christ's example in serving/loving the church and not looking to be served ourselves. Matt 20:28. Even if it means we need to adjust our own personal wardrobe preferences. The more we can point people to Jesus and not ourselves the better.

- Skirts and dresses need to be at least knee length as well as at least 4 fingers on the sleeves; no midsection showing; upper torso covered. No shorts, No sweat pants, No spandex/yoga pants/leggings. No clothing that is exceedingly tight. Pants with holes are ok but not above the knee cap.
- No Spaghetti straps, wife beaters, tube tops, halter tops, strapless dresses, and backless dresses. No article of clothing or apparel referencing drugs, alcohol, or secular bands as well as nothing deemed offensive by pastors and leaders. No Tie Dye. No neon colors of any kind. No shirts, or tops that expose cleavage.
- Shoes should be appropriate to the outfit. Make sure your shoes do not hinder you from moving freely in worship.
- Keep jewelry simple and tasteful.
- Hats/Beanies are ok as long as people can still see your face and expression as you lead in worship.
- Neutral earth tones are encouraged for all clothing. (Google this for the color palette.)
